

FRS Covid-19 Procedures 2021-2022

1. FRS is now all virtual until January 2022 or until further notice.
2. FRS teachers / teaching assistants over 12 years old will be required to be vaccinated before returning to in-person programming at HNT unless a medical exemption is provided. If boosters are mandated, then they will also be required for participation.
3. Vaccinations will be mandatory for students ages 2-12 once approval is granted unless a medical exemption is provided. If boosters are mandated, then they will also be required for participation.
4. Once FRS is in person, volunteer health monitors at FRS will be trained to monitor our safety procedures on Sundays during FRS.
5. Everyone will wear a mask while at FRS when in person.
6. We will practice social distancing to the best of our ability according to the guidelines set forth by King County during FRS when in person.
7. Snacks will not be served at FRS at least for first semester because we are virtual. Students will be encouraged to bring their own water bottle from home once FRS resumes.
8. Classroom spaces will be cleaned between student groups.
9. Pick up and drop off will be held in a staggered fashion at various entrances to the HNT building.
10. Students will have a staggered recess once FRS is in person.
11. Teachers will monitor the social distancing of the students once FRS is in person.
12. We will not have large group gatherings of more than 20 students at a time during our second semester.
13. FRS will not use the Upper Foyer or Chapel when FRS is in session.
14. If a person has a temperature above 100.4° F, they will be sent home from FRS.
15. If anyone is ill or sick in any form including respiratory symptoms, they should not attend FRS.

These policies and procedures at the Frankel Religious School are non-negotiable.
