**Safety & Security Assessment:** \$600 per year helps HNT create a safe and secure place to worship, learn, work and grow.

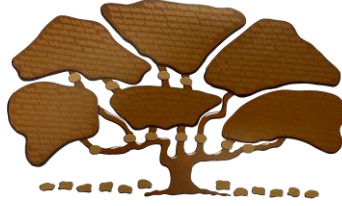
**Maintenance Assessment:** \$250 helps cover the cost of maintaining our aging facility.

### **The HNT Endowment Fund and The Tree of Life**

The HNT Endowment Fund is a legacy fund that provides support to the annual operating budget to enhance programming and religious services.
